General Summary:

Provides assistance with the planning and quality control of maintenance activities and duties primarily in support of electrical crane equipment.

Requirements:

Must have a HS Diploma or GED. At least one year of experience in an industrial maintenance environment or equivalent military experience. Experience troubleshooting 480vac 3 phase motor control systems and troubleshooting hydraulic equipment.

- Valid driver's license and a driving record that meets corporation standards
- Ability to provide written and/or electronic reports and verbally communicate
- Ability to work at heights greater than six feet off of the ground
- Ability to work varied hours, overtime and/or "on call" as needed
- This position requires standing, walking, sitting, lifting, carrying, pushing/pulling, balancing, kneeling and crawling

Preferred:

- Associate's degree in Industrial/Electrical/Mechanical field, technical diploma or related field, or equivalent vocational/technical training and experience
- At least one year of experience of electrical/mechanical troubleshooting and repair.
- PLC Programmer with knowledge of programmable logic controllers and their functions.
- Prior experience with cranes.
