The successful applicant will perform maintenance functions at both Balzano Terminal and Broadway Terminal. The successful applicant will be paid in accordance with current labor contract as:

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

PIPEFITTER/PLUMBING must be fully qualified and experienced (minimum five years) to perform journeyman level work as follows: Must be able to maintain, troubleshoot and repair major piping systems including but not limited to high- and low-pressure steam, air, water, sewage systems, and fire sprinkler systems including a wide variety of pumps (reciprocating, centrifugal, and positive displacement rotary pumps), valves, sewage ejectors, flushometers, etc.

Must be able to install all types of piping and associated equipment including, the ability to thread and weld pipe. Must be able to solder and braze copper, must be able to install plastic pipe (PVC, CPVC, ABS). Must have the ability to weld.

Must be able to read blueprints and calculate piping and equipment requirements for particular job installations. Must be able to burn metal and operate specialized metal working tools including drills, power saws, power threads, grinders, etc.

Must perform other maintenance work in addition to pipefitting as required, including but not limited to, the knowledge and ability to perform electrical maintenance and installation. Roof repairs, carpentry, masonry; nonstructural building repairs and any other work that may be assigned. Must be willing to work at heights in and on building and structures at Broadway and Balzano Terminals. Must be knowledgeable in troubleshooting and repairing underground piping.

Must follow all safety rules as required by South Jersey Port Corporation. Must be willing and able to work at heights in and on buildings and structures at the SJPC facilities and can work on low pressure boilers.

The New Jersey First Act, effective September 1, 2011, established residency requirements for all public employees. The applicant shall have their principal residence in the State of New Jersey.

- Must possess a Federal Transportation Worker Identification Credential issued by the Transportation Security Administration.
- Must possess a valid, unrevoked, and unsuspended driver's license.
- NJ Black Seal Low Pressure Boiler License maybe required.

TESTING:

All applicants for this job opening must be willing to take a written test to demonstrate qualification in one or all the above areas of specialization. A practical test in these areas will also be required. Management will judge whether an applicant is qualified for this position. Certain portions of the examination procedure may be waived by Management based on an applicant's experience in performing this level of work.
