ANSWERS TO FORMALLY SUBMITTED QUESTIONS

- Question 1. Can we backfill using spoils (as long as they're suitable)?
 - Answer 1. Yes.
- Question 2. Are we responsible for asphalt restoration or can we leave it at a rough grade?
 - Answer 2. Provide compacted subgrade to 6 inches below finish grade. The owner will provide the final 6 inches of bituminous asphalt paving.
- Question 3. Can unused spoils, old asphalt, etc. be left onsite or do we need to include transport and disposal?
 - Answer 3. Unused spoils from the excavation can be left on-site in an area designated by the owner.
- Question 4. For the air release replacement and flushing connection (Item 6):
 - To replace the isolation valve in the pit we will need to drain the FM. Assuming the need to drain the entire FM, after reviewing the drawings, I calculate approx. 910' of 3" piping. Can you confirm overall FM length and Dia?
 - Answer 4. Attached to the RFQ are the Taylor Wiseman Taylor drawings from 1987, Sheets 8 and 9. These drawings show the length of the 3-inch diameter D.I.P. pipe in both plan and profile.
- Question 5. Can the upstream pump stations be shut down until the isolation valve in the air release pit can be replaced?
 - Answer 5. Yes. The other pump stations can be shut down temporarily while the isolation valve is installed. This would be scheduled on a Saturday.
